As a part of Caithness Arts Week, 'Music at the Mill' on Saturday 23rd September, Thurso's Mill Theatre plays host to Johnny & Isaac Sutherland with their unique fusion of folk and jazz music for guitar.

Performing as Sutherland & Son with John "Fats" Sutherland on guitars, guitar synth and vocals and Isaac Sutherland also on guitars, guitar synth & vocals, the duo draw on a wide range of influences.

John being of a genuine sixties pedigree, has been involved in music during its progression from the birth of rock & roll right up to date. His first public performance at the age of five years old was the start of a long road taking him around the globe playing many different forms of music. At the forefront of the Caithness music scene, working with people like Graham Walker & Johnny Grey and a host of others, he has moved with the times whilst keeping an absolutely original approach to everything he does. Now at the age of sixty-two he shows no signs of slowing down.

Isaac Sutherland also started young. Tackling drums at the age of three he set out on a never ending musical journey. His musical upbringing was based around the sixties style of blues and rock & roll and he has since embraced a wide variety of different styles. Playing drums, bass, guitar & vocals he started band life on guitar in the mid eighties with the family's Sutherland Blues Band and also played with The J. Fats Band through its many incarnations. Isaac has also worked with a wide variety of acts including the Caithness Orchestra & Big Band, Geordie Jack & Caledonia and many other sessions in between. Together with his father he runs www.qpqproductions.com recording solo & duo projects as well as local acts & a number of Inverness based bands.
